In **Science** we will be learning about fossils. We will be looking at how the different types of rocks are formed and the process of fossilisation.

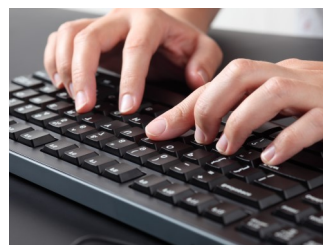


We will be looking at how the three different types of rocks are formed and the process of fossilisation.
