Here are some of the things we will be learning about throughout this half of the spring term...

Europe

We will be starting this theme by learning which countries make up Europe. We will learn about some of the key physical features of Europe. We will investigate some of the most significant man made landmarks of Europe and what it is like in the countries of Northern, Eastern and Western Europe.



English

English: We will be learning about the features of stories with morals and writing our own. We will look at platy scripts and their features. We will write letters after learning about the features of formal letters.

Key Texts: This half term, we will be reading Aesop's Fables from a range of different texts. We will be reading The Dark by Lemony Snicket to aid our letter writing.

Geography
